

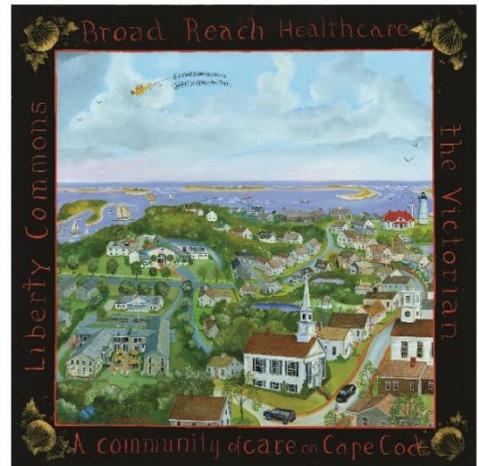

Text of Blast Call Notification to all resident families and employees via VoiceFriend.

Hello. It's Bill Bogdanovich, from Broad Reach.

The news this week is all about seeing each other.

Over 75 families participated in our Parades of Hope at both Liberty Commons and The Victorian. From all accounts, they were a good first step toward starting individual visits next week. The state's guidance allows us to coordinate 1:1 visits, by advance appointment only. The visits happen in designated outside spaces, require proper social distancing, screening and masks at all times, and a staff member must remain present throughout the visit. We also cannot permit you inside for any reason. Proper social distancing does mean hugs have to wait, so please do keep that in mind!

The update on testing and COVID-19 cases includes two staff who were tested based on symptoms. Both of their tests were negative. One resident was tested prior to a planned medical procedure, the results of which were also negative. There continue to have been no deaths from COVID-19, and there are no PPE shortages or other operational impacts at this time.

Finally, you may see us at the Chatham Planning Board on Monday evening. Our outpatient clinic at Liberty Commons will remain closed until such time as outside visitors of any type can safely return, so we are preparing to begin outpatient physical therapy services offsite, in the former Santander Bank building on Route 28. Hopefully it will just be for the summer, but we will be glad to bring this service back to the community, and have pre-scheduled over 60 appointments in the first week.
