Hi, It's Bill Bogdanovich from Broadreach, with a further update as the week comes to a close.

As you recall, last weekend, we had a Liberty Commons staff member who tested positive for COVID-19, in the course of our surveillance testing program. The staff member was not symptomatic and is not in a position providing clinical or personal care.

That triggered a number of things, including full PPE, suspension of visits and communal dining and activities, and patients and residents remaining in their rooms. It also increased the testing regimens across the board. All Liberty Commons patients/residents have been tested. Results are back on 70 of them so far, and all are negative.

All Liberty Commons staff has also been tested again. 129 of those results are back and all are negative, with 45 pending from the lab. Staff testing at this heightened level will occur again this week.

If there are no positive cases after next week's round of testing, we will be able to resume dining, activities and scheduled outdoor visits again, after all those results are back.

Additionally, federal regulations require that we specifically report on these additional points:

- ➔ PPE and hand hygiene supplies are on hand and in use.
- ➔ There are currently 121 patients and residents at Liberty Commons.
- ➔ We have access to COVID-19 testing.
- ➔ Staffing shortages are not an issue.
- ➔ Mitigating actions have been implemented to prevent or reduce the risk of transmission.
- ➔ There have been no COVID-19 deaths among residents and staff.
- ➔ We do not anticipate that normal operations of the facility will be altered.
